**Policy Title: Definition and Enforcement of
Academic Eligibility Rules**

Code No. 503.4R1

Any student who has a failing grade in more than one subject shall be declared ineligible for all activities (athletic and other activities). The ineligibility period will be 4 1/2 weeks. Grades will be checked at 4 1/2, 9, 13 1/2, and 18 week-periods each semester. If after a two week period the student is passing all subjects, their eligibility will be reinstated.

If students are ineligible for the summer, they will be ineligible to participate in four (4) games during the summer and 4 1/2 weeks in the fall. For all other activities the ineligibility shall be one event and 4 1/2 weeks in the fall. If after a two-week period in the fall a student is passing all subjects, their eligibility will be reinstated.

It shall be understood that summer will begin at the conclusion of the last day of school. During all ineligibility periods students must continue to practice, but are ineligible for participation, in competition or any other public performances.

It is felt that students should be academically eligible at the time they are participating and that semester grades reflect only an overall average for two quarters. Therefore, only mid-quarter and quarter grades will be considered in determining academic eligibility.

Ineligibility period will commence on the Monday immediately following the week in which it was determined. Eligibility will be reinstated immediately after all criteria have been met (grades were checked).
