**Policy Title: Student Progress Reports & Conferences**

**Code No. 505.1**

Students will receive a progress report at the end of each nine-week grading period. Students, who are doing poorly, and their parents, are notified prior to the end of the semester in order to have an opportunity to improve their grade. The board encourages the notification of students who have made marked improvement prior to the end of the semester.

Parent-teacher conferences shall be scheduled at least once each academic year in all grades, kindergarten through 12<sup>th</sup>. Such conferences shall be held after the close of the first quarter and shall supplement the student progress reports. Report cards will be issued at the close of each quarter. If parents so request, evening conferences may be arranged.

Parents, teachers, or principals may request a conference for students in grades kindergarten through twelve in addition to the scheduled conference time. Parents and students are encouraged to discuss the student's progress or other matters with the student's teacher.
