Policy Title: Middle School Promotion Policy

Code No. 505.2R

- I. Students in sixth, seventh and eighth grades may be required to repeat academic subjects that are failed for the year. If a student fails one subject, he moves on to the next grade in grade standing but may be required to repeat the subject failed. If a student fails two subjects, he/she shall repeat the two subjects failed and will be classified in the higher of the two grades. A student failing more than two subjects must repeat the entire grade.
- II. Exploratory courses are not repeated unless the grade is required. However, a low grade in any one subject would be most carefully considered before the student would be scheduled for future courses in that area. To take a senior high school course following a failing grade in an exploratory course, the student would be required to repeat the course or have departmental approval.
