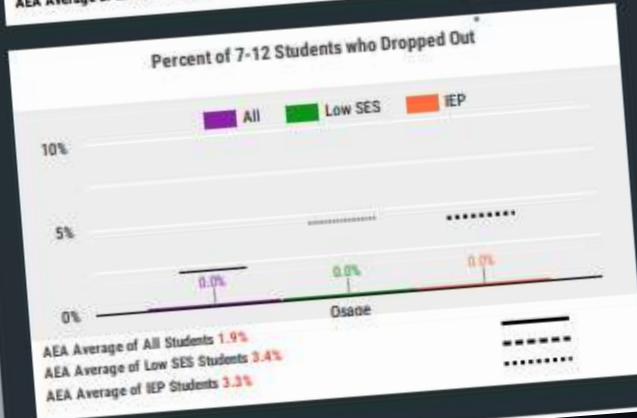
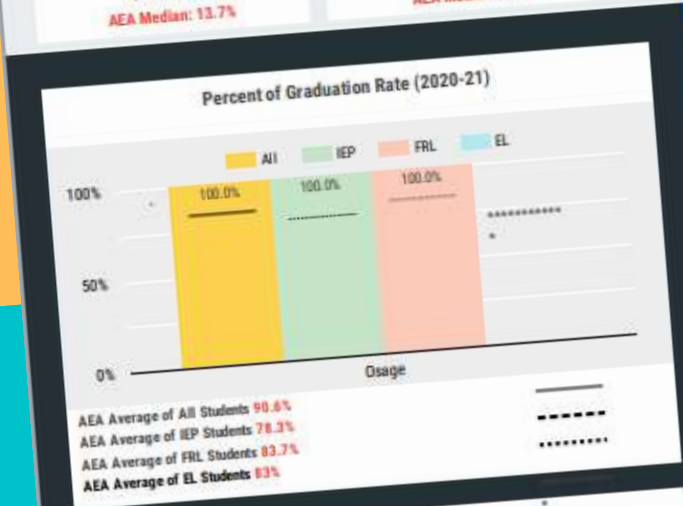

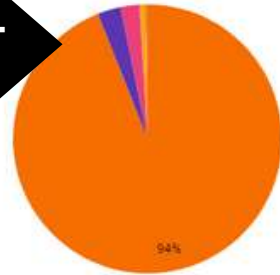


District Demographic

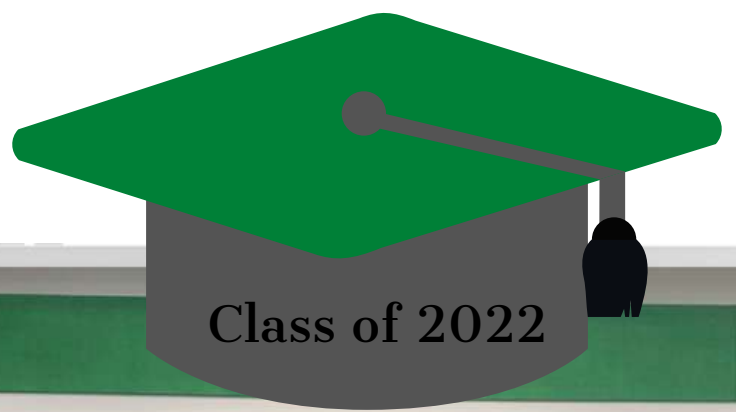

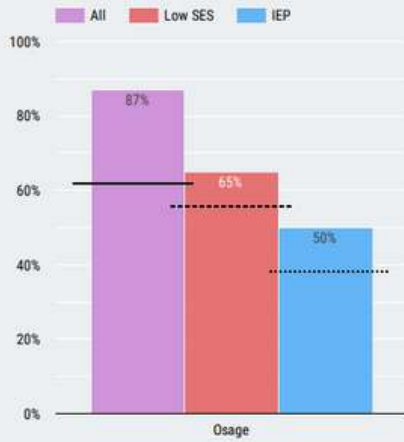

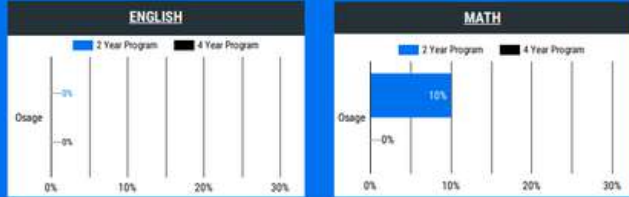


Postsecondary Intentions Compares AEA Average to School District Average

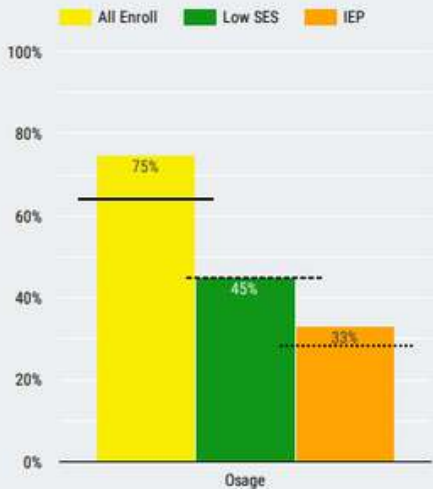

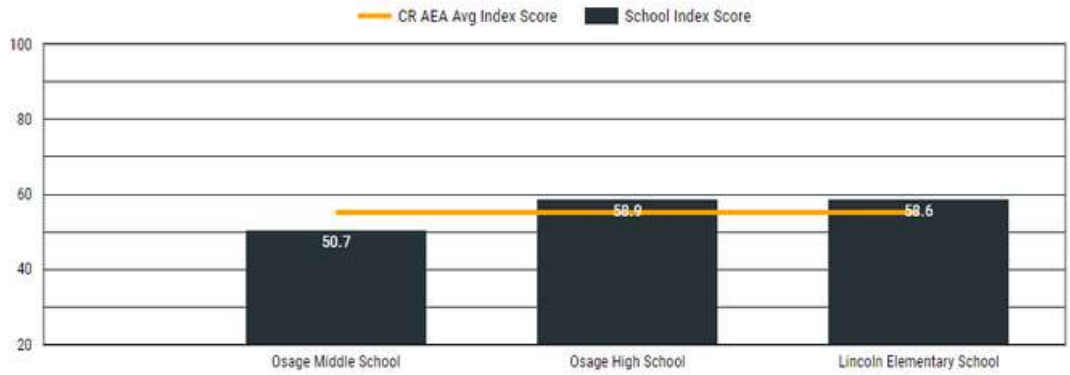


IOWA SCHOOL PERFORMANCE PROFILE
